Introduction

The **GHExtensions_FilterProductsCategory** extension for Magento 2 adds a column in the product admin panel that allows filtering products based on the categories they belong to. It also provides options to sort products in ascending or descending order by category name.

Installation of the Extension

Installation via Composer from Magento Marketplace

- 1. Access the Command Line:**
 - Connect to your server using SSH.
- 2. Run the Composer Command:**
 - Execute the following command to install the extension from Magento Marketplace:
`composer require gersonhernandez/filterproducts-category`
- 3. Update Composer Repository:**
 - Ensure the Composer repository is updated:
 - `composer update`
- 4. Enable the Extension:**
 - Once installed, enable the extension by running:
 - `bin/magento module:enable GHExtensions_FilterProductsCategory`
- 5. Update the Database:**
 - Run the following command to apply any database changes:
 - `bin/magento setup:upgrade`
- 6. Clear the Cache:**
 - Clear Magento's cache to ensure changes are reflected:
 - `bin/magento cache:clean`

Manual Installation

1. Download the Extension:

- Download the zip file of the extension from Magento Marketplace or from the provided source.

2. Extract the File:

- Extract the zip file on your local machine.

3. Upload the Extension to the Server:

- Use an FTP client or SSH to upload the extracted contents to the `app/code` directory of your Magento installation. The directory structure should be:
`app/code/GHExtensions/FilterProductsCategory`

4. Access the Command Line:

- Connect to your server using SSH.

5. Enable the Extension:

- Run the following command to enable the extension:
○ `bin/magento module:enable GHExtensions_FilterProductsCategory`

6. Update the Database:

- Run the following command to apply any database changes:
`bin/magento setup:upgrade`

7. Clear the Cache:

- Clear Magento's cache to ensure changes are reflected:
`bin/magento cache:clean`

Configuring the Extension

1. **Access the Magento 2 Admin Panel:**
 - Log in to your Magento 2 admin panel.
2. **Navigate to Extension Configuration:**
 - Go to **Stores** in the main menu.
 - Select **Configuration** from the submenu.
 - In the left menu, expand the **GHExtensions** section.
 - Click on **Filter Products Category**.
3. **Configure the Extension:**
 - In the configuration panel, find the **General** section.
 - Locate the **Enabled** field.
 - Set the value to **Yes** to enable the extension.
4. **Save the Changes:**
 - Click the **Save Config** button to save the changes.

Using the Extension

1. Access the Product Grid:

- In the admin panel menu, go to [Catalog](#).
- Select [Products](#) to view the product grid.

2. Use the Categories Column:

- The categories column added by the extension should be visible in the product grid.
- You can use this column to filter products by the categories they belong to.

3. Sort Products:

- The categories column also allows sorting of products.
- Click on the column header to toggle between ascending and descending order by category name.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with the extension, consider the following:

- **Check Configuration:** Ensure the extension is enabled in the configuration.
- **Cache:** Clear Magento's cache and your browser cache to ensure changes are correctly reflected.
- **Compatibility:** Verify that your version of Magento 2 is compatible with the extension.
